

Module 1-1 Japanese Vowels, Consonants, and Basic Sounds

In this module:

- You will learn and practice pronouncing the 46 basic sounds in Japanese.
- You will listen to and practice pronouncing words with the basic sounds.

In Japanese, there are 5 vowels ([a], [i], [u], [e], and [o]) and 10 consonants/semi-vowels ([k], [s], [t], [n], [h], [m], [y], [r], [w], and [N]). The vowels ([a], [i], [u], [e], [o]), combinations of the consonant/semi-vowel and vowel (ex. [k]+[a]), and the consonant [N] alone create 46 basic sounds in total.

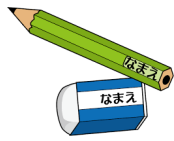
Practice I: Play the sound file to listen to each sound, and repeat it. For example, if you want to listen to あいうえお, you can play the sound file “1-1-1.”
